

Stake Family File Names for Temple Ordinances

The Oquirrh Mountain temple has recently established a new method for allowing patrons to submit family file cards to the temple that will enable members of the patrons' own stakes to complete the temple work when patrons are unable to complete the work on their own.

With this new policy there are a few things **all members need to know** about:

First, the temple requests that anyone who has names they would like to submit to the temple, will please give those name cards to representatives who have been trained in the proper protocol to ensure that things remain orderly. Currently, that means submitting names to Kay Hill in the 1st Ward (meeting in the Dixie Building): [801-949-8201](tel:801-949-8201); Nan Hill in the 2nd Ward (meeting in the Dixie Building): [801-671-9491](tel:801-671-9491); Liesl Thornley in the 6th Ward (meeting in the Westbrook Building): [801-966-8521](tel:801-966-8521); or Daniela Becerra in the Spanish branch (meeting in the Stake Center): [801-864-2287](tel:801-864-2287). We encourage members to follow protocol, thus preventing cards from being lost, mislabeled, or misfiled

Second, the temple has requested that each patron have **no more than 10 family file cards** in the drawer at a time, thus allowing all to have a chance to submit names, rather than having one or two patrons fill up the entire drawer. As soon as all ordinances have been completed and a card has been removed, another card can be submitted to replace it.

Third, anytime members of the stake attend the temple without family file cards of their own, they are encouraged to perform work for cards from our stake drawer. To do so, simply ask a temple worker to help you locate our stake's family file cards. The temple requests that members only take cards from their own stake; if there are no cards in the drawer for the ordinance you wish to perform, you may use temple names, as usual. **Youth** who wish to do work for family file cards in our stake can request a temple worker at the recommend desk to retrieve the names for them. When ordinances are completed, family file cards should be left at the temple for the submitter to retrieve as they wish.
